Several of the most current items that need attention involve the following:

- ✓ Google Doc: Parent/student information form needs to be completed ASAP. Link is on website and Canvas
- ✓ Communication: We will using Remind.com for messages to both students and parents—PLEASE accept the invitation to join!
- FairShare: a per-student commitment for chorus families to help raise funds to support the many activities and expenses of the program; over the last 2 years, we have reduced our planned formal fundraising so as to alleviate pressure on our families and surrounding community. However, this reduction of fundraising requires a slight increase in the FairShare commitment (due by October 2nd though preferred ASAP):
 - --Semester-long students (2nd pd. Mixed Chorus): \$40
 - -- Women's Ensemble (3rd pd.) **\$70** -- PCHS Chamber Choir :**\$99**

This fee is simply the difference between our expected income (via concert tickets, fundraising, etc.) and the proposed budget that allows students to have access to needed chorus resources. Included in this fee is a chorus t-shirt. *Benevolence is available to those needing financial assistance.*

- ✓ **Outfits:** Each of the choral groups have specific outfit requirements/expenses (see back of this letter). Sizing and ordering of these items will happen quickly in the semester. **Payment should be made before the outfits are ordered**. See the Handbook for more info. Again, **benevolence is available to those needing financial assistance.**
- ✓ **Choral parent meeting** on **Tuesday Sept. 5**th at 7:00pm in the chorus room. The meeting will involve introduction of both the choral booster officers and myself. We will have stations set up to:
 - o Register as an approved WCPSS Volunteer
 - o Pay/collect semester expenses (FairShare, outfits, donations, punch cards, etc.)

We will also explain the items above and discuss other important elements in the Handbook like outfit information/samples & class overviews, a presentation of our operating budget (including how FairShare commitments are allocated in), a review of the 2017-2018 calendar, information regarding fundraising, plus some time for various Q&A related to the choral program. If possible, please plan to attend as the support and engagement of our choral families is greatly intrinsic to our success as a program.

- ✓ Semester 1 Concerts 4:30 & 7:00pm—add to your calendar: Thurs. Oct. 26: Fall Concert; Tues. Dec. 19: Winter Concert
 - We have a matinee concert at 4:30 and an evening one at 7pm. Both are required for students. See Handbook.
- ✓ Please consider buying a **Concert Punch Card** at \$35 for 10-use pass. Or even better—consider making a TAX-DEDUCTIBLE **donation** to our booster group—*a* \$100 donation will earn a FREE Punch Card (\$65 is tax-deductible); This is a win-win for both families and the program!
